All employees or contract workers involved in Blackstone operations are responsible for performing every job in a manner that safeguards themselves and their fellow workers. This can be accomplished by exercising sound judgment, maintaining a high level of safety awareness, applying all education and training, understanding the scope of your job or task and the hazards involved, complying with all applicable legislation, and following safe work practices and procedures. Blackstone will ensure that workers and supervisors receive effective training in their specific work tasks to protect their health and safety.

It is everyone's responsibility to identify, correct, and immediately report to their supervisor or manager unsafe working conditions or personnel who are inadequately trained or equipped to perform their job safely.

Employees and contract workers will be encouraged to offer their suggestions as to how Blackstone can improve its safety program or procedures.
